TINTYPES is a charming musical revue focusing on the exciting yet tumultuous period of American history between the turn of the 20th century and the onset of World War I. The score is a blend of patriotic songs, romantic tunes and ragtime by the musical masters of the era, including George M. Cohan, John Philip Sousa and Scott Joplin. Conceived by Mary Kyte with Mel Marvin and Gary Pearle, **TINTYPES** played Broadway's John Golden Theatre in late 1980 through early 1981 and was nominated for three Tony Awards® that year, including Best Musical.

The cast of five, including Tony Award® winning actress Lynne Thigpen (*An American Daughter*) and multi-Tony® winning director Jerry Zaks (*Guys and Dolls*, *Six Degrees of Separation*, *Lend Me A Tenor*, *The House of Blue Leaves*), portray a variety of characters including hopeful strivers and dream-filled achievers among the common folk and politician William Jennings Bryan, radical Emma Goldman, inventors Thomas Edison and Henry Ford, among the famous. **TINTYPES** takes us through a time in our nation's development when the transcontinental railroad and Carnegie Hall were built, electricity and the telephone were introduced to homes, cowboy Theodore Roosevelt became President of the United States and automobiles joined horse-drawn carriages on city streets.
