Sophisticated Ladies was nominated for 8 Tony Awards® including Best Musical and won two: Hinton Battle as Best Featured Actor in a Musical and Willa Kim for Best Costume Design. Battle had created the role of the Scarecrow in the original company of *The Wiz* on Broadway and also has appeared in the Broadway companies of *Dancin'*, *Dreamgirls*, *Miss Saigon* and *Chicago*. The cast also featured Phyllis Hyman who later went on to a Grammy® winning career as a solo recording artist.

Mercer Ellington, Duke's son, conducted the Duke Ellington Orchestra which featured many of the original members who played with Duke but who came back for the Broadway musical. Mercer was not the only Ellington involved. His daughter Mercedes was in the original chorus and was the dance captain and assistant choreographer.
